Missed connection extension (Policy B)

On payment of additional premium

We will pay up to the amount shown in the schedule of cover for:

additional transportation and/or accommodation expenses incurred to:

1. join your connecting transport

Or

2. get you to your pre-booked final destination if you miss your connecting transport as a result of the cancellation or delay of 3 or more hours of your aircraft, watercraft or train on your initial international outbound or return journey due to adverse weather, mechanical breakdown or technical fault.

Provided:

- you check-in according to the itinerary provided by the tour operator or carrier and obtain written confirmation of the delay or cancellation from them.
- you can produce independent evidence in writing to 2. support any claim.
- you allow sufficient time to reach your connecting transport.

There is no cover provided under this section for anything mentioned in the General conditions and exclusions applying to all sections of cover in the main policy wording. Additionally, no cover is provided under this section for:

- circumstances which could reasonably have been anticipated at the date the insurance started or the trip was booked (whichever is the latter).
- withdrawal from service (temporary or otherwise) of an aircraft or sea vessel on the recommendation of the Civil Aviation Authority or a Port Authority or any similar body in any country.
